Camping Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I have to set up my own tent?

No. Our Empire State Ride team will set up your tent for you daily. We provide you with a twin size air mattress, fresh towels for the shower and a camping chair for each tent.

Q: How do I charge my device?

There is a charging station available at camp every night. Power will also be provided to some tents if a medical device needs battery.

Q: What should I pack for camping?

Riders should pack a twin size fitted sheet or sleeping bag. We encourage campers to bring a long sleeve shirt/sweatshirt and a pair of pants in case it gets chilly. Some riders have also recommended packing a battery-operated fan and a headlamp to make the tent as comfortable as possible overnight.

Ear plugs will be provided at the Hospitality, Updates and Beverages (HUB) area, but some riders who are light sleepers have also benefited from bringing noise-canceling headphones.

Q: Will I be able to sleep comfortably with so many outside noises, like the sound of a tent zipper or even snoring?

We know getting a good night's sleep is essential to success on the road! That's why ear plugs, in addition to other amenities, will be provided at the HUB.

Q: What do we do after dinner?

Riders are encouraged to take part in evening mission-based programming. Some nights there are games, live music and receptions. At camp, there will always be opportunities to meet other riders and spend time together. Riders can also schedule massages for a fee.

Q: Will I have access to a restroom and shower?

Yes, absolutely! Restrooms or portable restrooms and a traveling shower truck are available on site.
